## Burnhamville Township Annual Meeting

## March 12, 2024

The annual meeting of the residents of Burnhamville Township was held at the Burtrum Community Center on Tuesday, March 12, 2024. The meeting was called to order at 8:20 by the clerk Shirley Hulinsky. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Pam Throener nominated Janice Lind as moderator. Bruce Johnson seconded the motion and upon vote motion passed.

The minutes of the annual meeting held on March 14, 2023 were read by the clerk Shirley Hulinsky. Motion was made by Joe Muellner and seconded by Mike Berscheit to approve the minutes as read. Motion passed.

The clerk and treasurer's financial report was read by the clerk. Bruce Johnson made a motion to accept the report as presented. Motion was seconded by Joe Muellner. Upon vote motion passed.

Chair Mike Berscheit presented the road report which was available for all to read.

In old business the cost of Clean-up Day last year was higher than the board would like and there were issues using Main Street. Options for different places to hold clean-up day were discussed possibly using alley way, side street or old school lot. Township board is working on clearing road ditches and will work with contractors to get large rocks and more trees removed for better visibility.

For new business the township election results were announced with Joe Muellner and Shirley Hulinsky being re-elected for their respective offices. Donation request was discussed and turned down. A resident requested road grading improvements on Dunlin Road so that there are not piles on the edges of the roads causing water to stay on the road. Board will discuss with contractor.

The budget was discussed next. Since last year's expenses were close to the levy discussion was held on keeping it the same and using investments if township needed more money. Bruce Johnson made a motion to leave the levy the same at \$20,000.00 for general revenue, \$160.000.00 for road and bridge and \$35,000.00 for fire. Joe Muellner seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

Next year's election voting hours will again be from 5 until 8 pm on a motion by Joe Muellner and a second from Janice Lind. The annual meeting will be held at 8:20 pm following the election stated in a motion from Shirley Hulinsky and a second from Joe Muellner. Motions passed with all voting in favor.

Mike Berscheit made a motion to adjourn and Joe Muellner seconded that motion. Meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
