Burnhamville Township Annual Meeting March 10, 2020

The annual meeting of the residents of Burnhamville Township was held at the Burtrum Community Center on Tuesday, March 10, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 8:20 by the clerk Shirley Hulinsky. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Don Brown nominated Karl Lawin as moderator, he turned it down. Bruce Johnson nominated Don Brown for moderator. Shirley Hulinsky seconded the motion to appoint Don as moderator and upon vote motion passed.

The minutes of the annual meeting held on March 12, 2019 were read by the clerk Shirley Hulinsky. Motion was made by Mike Berscheit and seconded by Karl Lawin to approve the minutes as read. Motion passed.

The clerk and treasurer's financial report was read by the clerk. Bruce Johnson made a motion to accept the report as presented. Motion was seconded by Nick Purket. Upon vote motion passed. A comment was made on which formula is used to determine PILT.

Chair Mike Berscheit presented the road report.

In old business the clean-up day and recycling every-other Saturday are well used. This year's clean-up day is scheduled for Saturday, May 16 and plan to have it the same time 9-11 am.

For new business election results were announced with Mike Berscheit and Shirley Hulinsky being reelected for their respective offices. The township did buy the brush hog mower to help trim ditches and supervisors think it is working well. The board has no major project scheduled for this year. One resident asked about changing the Y intersections. He thought it would make it easier for road contactor to maintain road.

The budget was discussed next. The Road and Bridge fund is low. After discussion Bruce Johnson made a motion to raise the Road and Bridge fund to \$140,000.00. Nick Purket seconded the motion. Mike Berscheit made a motion to keep the levy for the revenue and fire funds the same at \$20,000 for Revenue and \$33,000 for fire. Motion was seconded by Nick Purket. Upon vote motion passed.

One resident brought up the issue of Fitz Road being well used. He requested the board look into dust control spraying the whole road and getting help from Jennie – O to pay for it with their several turkey barns on that road.

Next year's election voting hours will again be from 5 until 8 pm on a motion by Mike Berscheit and a second from Bruce Johnson. The annual meeting will be held at 8:20 pm following the election stated in a motion from Mike Berscheit and a second from Karl Lawin. Motions passed with all voting in favor. Mike Berscheit made a motion to adjourn and Bruce Johnson seconded that motion. Meeting adjourned at 9:02 p.m. Shirley Hulinsky, Burnhamville Township Clerk
