Burnhamville Township Annual Meeting

March 14, 2023

The annual meeting of the residents of Burnhamville Township was held at the Burtrum Community Center on Tuesday, March 14, 2023. The meeting was called to order at 8:40 by the clerk Shirley Hulinsky. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Karl Lawin nominated Don Brown as moderator. Brenda Schwanke seconded the motion and upon vote motion passed.

The minutes of the annual meeting held on March 8, 2022 were read by the clerk Shirley Hulinsky. Motion was made by Mike Berscheit and seconded by Bruce Johnson to approve the minutes as read. Motion passed.

The clerk and treasurer's financial report was read by the clerk. Jim Bieniek made a motion to accept the report as presented. Motion was seconded by Mike Berscheit. Upon vote motion passed.

Chair Mike Berscheit presented the road report which was available for all to read. There was a question of how the crushed tar on Dunlin Road was holding up in the snow. The board will check on the road condition after the snow melts.

In old business our area was affected by two severe storms in May 2022. Todd County qualified for FEMA assistance for both storms. The clerk worked with FEMA to get \$31,535.67 in assistance for road repairs of those storms. The cost of Clean-up Day last year was higher than the board would like. So for this year we put bids out to try to get a better estimate for the costs. Not sure if the City of Burtrum will do it this year.

For new business the township. Donation request were discussed and turned down. Election results were announced with Mike Berscheit and Pam Throener being reelected for their respective offices. Residents thought the contractor was doing a great job with snow plowing this year.

The budget was discussed next. Whereas the levy was raised last year, Bruce Johnson made a motion to leave the levy the same at \$20,000.00 for general revenue, \$160.000.00 for road and bridge and \$35,000.00 for fire. Mike Berscheit seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

Next year's election voting hours will again be from 5 until 8 pm on a motion by Shirley Hulinsky and a second from Mike Berscheit. The annual meeting will be held at 8:20 pm following the election stated in a motion from Shirley Hulinsky and a second from Bruce Johnson. Motions passed with all voting in favor.

Don Brown made a motion to adjourn and Mike Berscheit seconded that motion. Meeting adjourned at 9:25 p.m. Shirley Hulinsky, Burnhamville Township Clerk
